In 1923, Legacy made a promise to help families carry on with their lives after the loss or injury of a loved one in military service. It was a simple promise that Legacy has kept for a century; providing the same stability, guidance and assistance that a partner would normally provide to his or her family.

Today, Legacy supports over 40,000 people across Australia to ensure they suffer no social or financial disadvantage due to the loss or incapacitation of a veteran.

Across South-East, Central and Western Queensland, Legacy Brisbane supports over 5,700 people, including 5,446 widow(er)s, 170 youth and 125 people with a disability. To ensure service delivery within each community, Legacy relies on the support of more than 253 Legacy volunteers (known as Legatees) and staff.

Elizabeth's Story

Elizabeth was only 38 when she lost her husband Barry.

"He had a massive heart attack. We never expected it. He had no long-term health problems. He was an otherwise healthy person."

But what made Barry's death even harder for Elizabeth to make sense of was that he had only recently returned home from serving in the Vietnam War. Barry had made it back safely from Vietnam, and was home for 18 months before he died.

When Barry died, Elizabeth's whole world changed in an instant. No longer an army wife, instead, Elizabeth found herself the single mum of four young children. Her oldest, fifteen, her youngest, only just turned three.





Elizabeth's Story



In the wake of tragic loss, Legacy opened up a whole new life to Elizabeth. Legacy provides widows like Elizabeth with a caring community, so they can form new friendships and fight debilitating feelings of loneliness.

Legacy Youth Leadership Program

170 Legacy Youth are mentored through leadership and personal development skills, promoting a sense of connectedness and belonging, and assist with their transition from teenagers into adulthood.

Family Assist Program

More than 25 families a year engage with Legacy in times of crisis through the Family Assist Program. Legacy provides flexible and practical support to families of veterans who have an injury or illness due to their service.

Widow Support Program

Over 5,400 widows are supported each year, with over 1,000 welfare contact calls made to isolated widows across South East, Central & Western Queensland.
